## Shri Datta Jayanti

Saturday, December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018 4:30 pm – 6:00 pm



Sri Dattatreya is considered to be an incarnation of the Divine Trinity *Brahma*, *Vishnu* and *Shiva*, and depicted with three heads. The word *Datta* means "Given". Datta is called so because the divine trinity has "given" themselves in the form of a son to the sage couple *Atri* and *Anasnya*. He is the son of *Atri*, hence the name "*Atreya*."

He is always shown to be surrounded by four dogs and a cow. The four dogs represent the four Vedas: Rigveda, Yajurveda, Atharvaveda, and Samaveda. Dattatreya is supposed to have taken 16 avatars. The first avatar is Shripad Shri Vallahh and the second is Narasimha Saraswati. The Shirdi Sai Baba (Shirdi, Maharashtra) is also considered to be a Dattatreya's avatar. Dattatreya tradition is mainly followed in Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.

## One of his Maha Mala Mantras is:

Kashaya vastram kara danda dharinam Kamandalam padma karena shankham Chakram gadha booshita bhushanadhyam Sripada rajam sharanam prapadye

Wearing orange garment and holding a holy stick, a kettle of water, a lotus, a conch, in his hands a discus, a mace as adornments/ornaments, I surrender to Sri Dattatreya.
