We will be chanting of shri Lalita sahasranama stotram, Mahalakshmi stotram and Saraswati stotram. We are calling for the participation of 108 married women (suvasini, i.e. husband alive) in this event. There will be a puja to Devi with kumkum, haridra (turmeric) and flowers in which all can participate, under the direction of temple priests. It will be very auspicious if husbands also join in this puja. Please participate enthusiastically and make this event a successful celebration at your temple.
