

Outreach and Interfaith Committee Activities Jan-Aug 2025.

The Outreach and Interfaith committee have been busy doing charitable work in the local community on behalf of our temple. In March the committee donated basic needs such as soaps, towels, washcloths etc to East side family shelter in Baltimore County.

GBT is blessed to join a consortium of faith-based organizations in Carroll County in providing a hot midday meal on Fridays for the needy at a soup kitchen in Carroll County. Approximately 60 to 65 meals are served at Westminster United Methodist Church in downtown Carroll County. Our group participates about four to five times a year. Members plan, cook, serve heart vegetarian meals.

On April 27th, the committee conducted the Annual Interfaith Dialogue at GBT on the topic of the role of music and dance in worship and spirituality. Seven religious groups participated enthusiastically.

Member Ram Shankar hosted students from Maryvale Preparatory School and Boys Latin School at our temple at the request of their history teacher. He gave them a temple tour and a talk on Hinduism.

Some committee members have been attending meetings of the Carroll County Interfaith Alliance for Racial Justice.

We've worked closely with community leaders to plan unique celebrations for each group. Under Pankaj Grover's leadership, we launched the Sunday Langar program, which has been well received and fully sponsored through November. Our Balvihar program, led by Manu Agarwal and a team of devoted teachers, just concluded the 2024–25 year. We continue to focus on improving the curriculum and boosting attendance. Looking ahead, we're planning the Navgraha Pranaprathistha in early October and completing the Navgraha room renovations. Our Capital Project Committee is working on replacing the HVAC system and roof, with a fundraising goal of \$500,000. I'd like to express heartfelt thanks to retiring trustees Praful Vani, Sanjeev Gholap, Sai Batchu, and Srinivas Mallampalli. Praful and Sanjeev will continue supporting
